As you continue to create: THINK

Reflection

- What worked, what didn't?
- Who attended and did you reach your target participants? I.e. Women, Men, Youth, Seniors, Visitors etc.
- Where people comfortable with location?

1st Timer?

If you have never hosted or planned a prayer room, do some research. There are lots of resources such as:

- the ladies in this room!
- the CBWOQ website https://baptistwomen.com/ and various online apps like Pinterest etc. I don't claim to get stations all by myself, there are lots of online resources ready to share.
- Share your ideas and thoughts with others in your church. Take the ideas you find and make them your own, to suit your space and participants needs.

As you continue to create: **DO**

Lots of praying, planning and execution.

When the ideas come to host a new prayer room, pray that the theme will reflect the current issues or desires your church may be facing or needed at that time. Discuss the ideas with your group and choose a theme verse or a certain passage. Recite this verse and theme and remember that the Holy Spirit will be your guide. Pray that the words chosen will be your guide to the stations that you create.

Gather your supplies and Go! Have Fun with it, it should be just as rewarding for you as for your participants.


As you continue to create: REMEMBER

- 1. Remember that Prayer Stations may not be for everyone.
- 1. Remember to PRAY! Every step, from the first idea of creation to the last person to leave. Pray for those who will be either (or both) the planners and the participants.
- 2. Remember to share! We can all benefit from each other's experiences. MOST IMPORTANTLY! Remember to Use God's Word It's easy to get caught up in our own ideas and creativity but always remember Who's words we need to use. Show this in your stations that all work is bible-based.

A Holy Nation

Items needed:

- Table with table cloth
- Chair
- Basket with pens/markers
- Prepared red, orange and yellow flames on fishing wire (see picture below)
- Cut out of dove (if can find a dove kite?)
- Hoop tied to dove as shown
- Framed instructions (This one is best used in two frames)

- 1) Cut a strand of fishing wire about 1 metre long.
 - 2) On the red flame write the name(s) of your church, prayer group, or faith community.
- 3) On the orange flame write the name(s) of your school, work, community group etc.
- 4) On the yellow flame write the name(s) of those in your close circle, whether family, friends, mentors etc.
- 5) Tape your flames to the strand like the example shown and tie or tape the strand of flames on the dove mobile. Pray as you experience the Holy Spirit moving through the flames here, let these names remind us that we are connected and linked together as God's Holy Nation.

Called- This Little Light of Mine

You are chosen with a purpose. You are brought out of the darkness of sin and given the wonderful light of salvation so you can help others. You see, you are blessed to be a blessing and given light to shine to others. Most of all, you are called to point others to the one, true, never-interrupted light — Almighty God!

Items needed:

- Medium table with two chairs
- Cut out paper candles
- Pencil crayons, crayons or markers
- Tape
- Backboard to attach the candles to with heading "This Little Light of Mine" (deco idea
 for board is to attach music sheet with "This little light of mine" on it <u>or</u> a picture of the
 world.) Have candles going around it.
- Framed instructions

Instructions:

This Little Light of Mine

As God's Holy Spirit lives in you, He gives you the power to bring God's love and light to our world. As you live for Jesus, other people see your light and understand better just what God wants for them, too.

Read the following verses:

- Sharpies
- Framed instructions

Instructions:

"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." John 1: 5

In the verse above, Christ is described as the light that will not be overcome by darkness. Therefore whatever darkness we face, Christ's light will shine through.

Where in your life do you need Christ's to shine?

What darkness to you want to name in order to receive clarity and strength?

Write those prayers on a vinyl piece. Peel the backing off and place on the lantern surrounding the candle.

May Christ's light shine through your prayers and give you peace.

- A medium table with table cloth
- Chair
- Framed instructions
- Address-label stickers and pens

Loved- Out of the darkness and into HIS light

Supplies needed:

- build a large free-standing cross (ours was made out of 4x4s)
- Paint the cross black, use red paint pens to write the bad list on one side of the cross
 (fill the cross with words even if you need to repeat a few) Use white paint pens to
 write the good list on the other side of the cross (fill the cross with words even if you
 need to repeat a few)
- Small table with framed instructions or can hang instructions on the wall

(Set the cross somewhere that worshipers have access to both sides)

- Undesired List: Unloved, Unlovable, Unworthy, Ugly, Worthless, Useless, Forgettable,
 No good, Used, Overlooked, Ignored, Hated, Outcast, Stupid, Guilty, Forgotten, Alone
- Desires of the Heart List: Loved, Chosen, Worthy, Beautiful, Valuable, Useful, Important, Holy, Noticed, Loved, Liked, Invited, Picked, Forgiven, Remembered, Family, Child of God, Saint, Changed, Reborn, Renewed, Restored, Loved, Loved, Loved, Respected, Welcome, Transformed

Instructions:

This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:9-10 (NIV)

It is the cross where God proved His love for us. But many times it is hard for us to feel very loved. The words of our own mind and the words of others are more real to us than the words of God.

Look at the front side of the cross (the side with the red words). Read the words that are written there. As you come to a word that you feel is true about your life, or that others have called you or have made you feel, then place your hand on that word.

The beauty of the cross is that none of those words are true about you. God loves you and proved that love in the cross. This means that you are important to God.

Move to the other side of the cross and read the words there that are true about you. Place your hand on any that are hard to believe and ask God to speak the truth of those words to your soul. Listen... He is calling you out of the darkness and into His light.

Loved- Out of the darkness and into HIS light

This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:9-10 (NIV)

- 3) Listen...Listen... He is calling you out of the darkness and into His light.

Out of the Darkness and into the Light

Items Needed:

- · big screen or hanging sheet that is black
- a large cross behind it lit up by the light
- a light on stand behind the cross with switch that is on a cord so it can be attached to side of the sheet/screen, should cast a lighted cross on the black (If no room for big screen room, can set up smaller version on table)

Instructions:

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people. You are a royal priest, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for He called you out of the darkness into His wonderful light. (NLT)

- 1) Take a moment to stare at the blackness of the sheet/screen.

 Think about what darkness God has brought you out of in your life.
- 2) Turn the switch on that is hanging on the right (or left) of the blackness.
- 3)See that He has called you out of the darkness into His light.
- 4) Praise Him in prayer that He has called you and you no longer have to be in darkness. Thank Him that you can show others the goodness of God.

(When you are finished, please turn back off the light for the next person)

Out of the Darkness and into the Light Instructions:

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people. You are a royal priest, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for **He called you out of the darkness into His**wonderful light. (NLT)

- 1) Take a moment to stare at the blackness of the sheet/screen. Think about what darkness God has brought you out of in your life.
 - 2) Push the red button on the cord that is at the side of the blackness.
 - 3)See that He has called you out of the darkness into **His** light.
- 4) Praise Him in prayer that He has called you and you no longer have to be in darkness. Thank Him that you can show others the goodness of God.

(When you are finished, please turn off the light for the next person)

Remember Why You Are Where You Are!

Declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 1 Peter 2:9 —

- Medium Table with table cloth

Instructions:

"God does not choose the gifted. God gifts those God calls and chooses.

The challenge is to respond to this call."

"You did not choose me; I chose you and appointed you to go and bear much fruit, the kind of fruit that endures. And so the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name."

John 15.16

- 2. Use the prayer provided to guide you, or pray on your own.
 - 3. Listen for God's words to speak to your heart.
 - 4. Think about how you can use these gifts to touch others.

TRUE NORTH

- compass(es) and magnet(s)
- labels on magnets with "distractions" on them ie: clothes, cell phone, job, social media etc
- Medium sheets with compass printed on it, space for "True North" at the top
- Pens
- Signs or backdrop board with bible verse on it (Prov 4:10), decorative visuals such as arrows, maps, GPS etc
- Framed instructions
